The children in our church became more attentive and focused to their lessons. They arrived on time and very eager to bring their siblings and friends to the church which resulted in an increase in our attendance. Even our young adults (teenagers) took the lessons seriously and they were challenged to serve as teachers and assistant teachers to the younger children. As a result, many of our church members became more willing to serve in whatever way they can. We were able to start a Bible Study Center for children.
